GOALS OF OUR TEEN PROGRAM, WHICH HOSTS THE MUSIC PROGRAM

- Create a safe, productive, social learning environment for adolescents.
- Increase access to academic resources including computers, resource materials and walk-in personalized academic support
- Increase English language skills through intensive adolescent English courses offered three evenings a week
- Improve access to books and create a reading for pleasure culture
- Encourage teen leadership and community engagement through youth management structure and youth driven community impact projects
- Promote cultural understanding by establishing inter-cultural relationships between teens and volunteers
